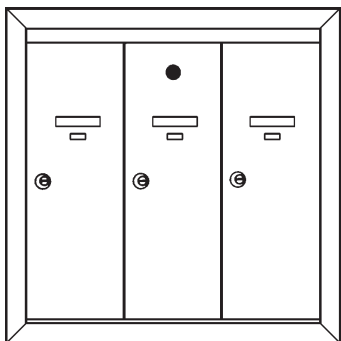




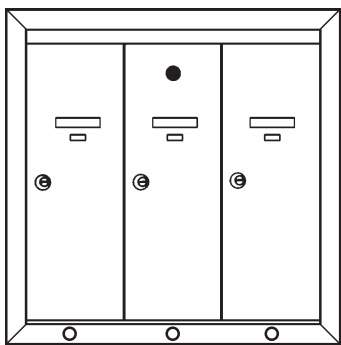

ARCHITECTS' and ENGINEERS' SPECIFICATIONS

The Vertical mail boxes shall be Alpha Communications®/ Florence 1250 (or P1250 with pushbuttons) series, or approved equal. Mail boxes shall be constructed of extruded aluminum, with striated finish to minimize marring or scratching. Mail boxes (and all related accessories) shall be finished in (Nat. Anodized Aluminum or Gold color or Dark Brown color). Contractor shall provide any key keepers, alphabetical directories, semi-recessed collars (SR120 series), or full surface collars (SM125 series), as required for a proper installation, in a matching finish to the mail boxes. Mail boxes shall be (single or double) row mounted, and each compartment shall be provided with a 5-pin cylinder lock, with 2 keys per lock. Locks shall be available with a minimum of 1,000 possible key combinations.

PLEASE NOTE: As of 10/05/2006 the 1250 series mailboxes are no longer USPS Approved for new installations, or for "major renovations". They can only be installed as direct replacements for previous 1250 series mailboxes that need to be replaced.

1250 Series Vertical Style Mail Boxes

The Alpha Communications® 1250 (and P1250) series vertical style mail boxes can be used in almost any size multi-residential building with three (3) or more mail receiving tenants. They are available in sizes of three (3) to seven (7) compartments in each unit.

The trim and doors have striated vertical lines to resist scratching and marring. All compartment doors come equipped with 5-pin cylinder locks with 2 keys per lock. 1,000 key combinations are provided to avoid possible duplication, and to maintain security.

These boxes can be fully recessed mounted in a 6.75" deep wall or can be semi-recessed with the SR120 series collar in a 3.75" deep wall. You can even fully surface mount these boxes with the SM125 series collar. All 1250 series boxes are available with built-in push-buttons, to allow for apartment bell or chime signals. Simply add the prefix 'P' in front of the model number, to order the boxes with the push-button option.

Choose from standard stock finishes of Natural Anodized Aluminum or Gold color. Dark Brown color available at extra cost, on a special-order basis. Matching key keepers and alphabetical directories are also available to complete your mail box installation.
